Pantheon helps Delta win EPA award

A treatment process developed by a Valley firm has helped **Delta Air Lines Inc.** land an award from the **Environmental Protection Agency**.

Delta picked up the award from the EPA's Design for Environment program using Phoenix-based **Pantheon Chemical's** PreKote surface pretreatment.

Pantheon pushes PreKote as an environmentally friendly product that doesn't use chromium as an aircraft surface treatment.

"This is an important step in the aerospace industry's efforts to eliminate toxins in the painting of aircraft," said Pantheon Chemical CEO Laura Roberts.
